The promise that God is with us provides
Strong protection that eliminates fear during times of chaos. (1-3)
<u>Gladness</u> that endures during times of <u>opposition</u> . (4-7)
<u>Victory</u> that demonstrates His Lordship over all <u>creation</u> . (8-11)
Questions for Discussion:
What are some of the issues in our world today that can tempt us to fear?
Are there troubles you personally are facing today that tempt you to fear? If so, what are they?
What in the teaching of this Psalm can help turn your fears into confident faith in God?
How easy is it for you to "be still" (v. 10)?
What can you do this week - to slow down, stop striving, take a breath, pause – enough to experientially know that God is God?
